

TECH TIP OF THE MONTH



TIPS FOR GOING TOPLESS

With Spring upon us and Summer fast approaching, the desire to remove the Winter hardtop on our Thunderbirds and raise the soft top becomes more and more tempting. Utilizing the soft top always gives us more options for the upcoming warm sunny days.

Here are a few suggestions for waking that soft top from its Winter's nap.

- 1. Remove the hard top. This is a two-person job. DO NOT try it alone unless you have a hoist.
- 2. Pick a warm, sunny day. (Preferably 70-80 degrees.)
- 3. Place the car in the sun and raise the top to where it will sit relaxed on top of the car. DO NOT latch at this time.
- 4. Let the top sit in the sun for 3-4 hours to really warm up. (This warm-up period will allow the material to stretch properly which will ultimately prolong the life of the top.)
- 5. When top is nice and warm, follow proper latching procedure.
- 6. Clean top with a damp cloth or soft bristled brush. (A clean top is a happy top)
- 7. This procedure should be used before latching any soft top that has been sitting in the boot for an extended period of time. Now that you've properly stretched the top, it should be ready to put up or down for the rest of the Summer.


